Added a new scheduled task that takes a backup of all the FM databases. This runs every night and backs up the main FM database and the document database(s). It also backs up and shrinks the database log files. Backup files are kept for two days, the backup task will delete older files before doing a new backup.

This scheduled task has three configuration parameters, accessible in the Admin UI under "System parameters", "Advanced" tab:

- enabled/disabled. If disabled, no automatic backups are done.
- the destination folder where the backup files are written to. This is a folder on the machine where SQL Server is running. The folder must exist and the user running SQL Server must have privileges to create files there.
- the time of day (hour) when the task should run. This can be anywhere between 18:00 and 06:00 (backup cannot be run during working hours).
